How to Stick to a Budget When Prices are High

Inflation, or a general increase in prices and a fall in the purchasing power of money, has become a reality lately and many of us have felt the pinch on our finances. When prices are high, there are some things you can do to both reduce spending as well as bolster income.

- Use store brands instead of name brands.
- Plan meals to curb impulse buys at the grocery store.
- Brew your own coffee at home and take your lunch to work.
- Take on a second job or start a side business.
